The VMSINSTAL-able, DECwindows Motif v1.2-5 TK50 tape kit is intended for VMS VAX v5.5-2 ONLY! Do not attempt to install this VMSINSTAL tape kit on any VAX systems that are not running VMS VAX v5.5-2.

If you are operating an OpenVMS VAX Version 6.2 (or higher) system and you have been shipped DECwindows Motif v1.2-5 on TK50 Tape, please contact your local Compaq Sales Representative and inquire about exchanging the TK50 media for the proper installation media intended for your operating system environment.

If you have mistakenly used the VMSINSTAL method to load Decwindows Motif v1.2-5 on any post-v5.5-2 system, the only supported methods of recovery are:

- 1) Restore the system backup that was made before the Decwindows Motif installation.
- 2) Reinstall the VMS operating system.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

The situation reported in this document is only present when a user attempts to use VMSINSTAL to install DECwindows Motif V1.2-5 on a VAX system running a version other than VMS V5.5-2. Since Alpha systems use PCSI only, the Alpha-based kits are unaffected.
