PROBLEM STATEMENT:

Performing a firmware update on an AlphaStation 500 System using the AlphaSystems Firmware Update CD V5.4 may render the system inoperable, due to a problem in the FLASH Prom programming routine in the AS500_V7_0.EXE/.SYS update image, which contains the latest Console Firmware V7.0-10. The problem is intermittent, and may fail frequently, infrequently, or not at all on a given system. The problem exists whether the image is booted via the CD, or from a floppy, or from the network.

The only way to recover at this point is to move the jumper on the system board from position J11 to J13, and boot a recovery floppy containing an older update image which does not have the problem. After that, the jumper must be returned to J11 for normal operation).
