Power Cord Replacement Procedure

1. To power-down the DECSA,
 - a) set the console key switch to the "OFF" position.
 - b) set the circuit breaker, located at the rear of the unit, to the "OFF" (0) position.
2. Remove the power cord and replace with the new power cord.
3. Power-up the DECSA.
 - a) Set the circuit breaker to the "ON" (1) position.
 - b) Set the console key switch to the "ON" position.
4. Check that power is available. The power LED on the console should be illuminated.
